- Aripiprazole in treatment of resistant schizophrenia.
- Comparison between Risperdal liquid and Haldol IM in acute agitation in patients with schizophrenia and bipolar disorder.

Conducted clinical evaluations on patients, including Brief Cognitive Rating Scale (BCRS), Global Deterioration Scale (GDS), Hamilton Psychiatric Rating Scale for Depression, and Clinical Global Impression (CGI). Performed psychometric evaluations in the Inpatient Psychiatric Unit, the Psychiatric Observation Suite, and the Psychiatric Emergency Room. Administered SCI-PANSS in schizophrenic patients and Abnormal Involuntary Movement Scale (AIMS). Interviewed family members of patients in the context of assessment modality involving activities of daily living in cases of schizophrenic disorders.
